Clean Sweep is a limited funded program designed to help people properly dispose of unwanted hazardous materials from their homes and properties.

\*No early drop-offs will be accepted at the Highway Department or Landfill before the Event\*

### Examples of Hazardous Materials --Accepted at No Charge--

#### Automotive:

- Fuel Additives
- Starter Fluids
- Transmission Fluids
- Brake Fluids
- Degreasers
- Automotive Batteries

#### Household:

- Oil & Lead Based Paints
- Turpentine and Varnish
- Drain and Oven Cleaners
- Pool Chemicals
- Photo Chemicals
- Cleaning Solvents
- Pharmaceuticals
- Lithium Batteries

#### Garden & Lawn Care:

- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Fungicides
- Poisons
- Weed Killer

#### Miscellaneous:

- Grease and Rust Solvents
- Paint Thinners/Strippers
   Removers
- Adhesives
- Wood Preservatives
- Mercury containing products

   Except Light Bulbs
- Unknown Chemicals

## Examples of Hazardous Materials

#### -- Moderate Disposal Charge--

- Antifreeze
- Used Motor Oil
- Latex Paint
- Tires
- Freon Appliances (Please dispose of old food in Refrigerators and Freezers before arrival)
- TV's
- Computer Equipment
- Light Bulbs
- Acid & NiCd Batteries

There may be additional charges for larger quantities or unusual products\*
